

THANK YOU, Holy Trinity Parishioners!!

Due to the generosity and caring of HT parishioners, your St. Vincent de Paul Society was able to serve more people through the 2021 Links of Friendship program than ever before! In rural Appalachia, we provided over 500 individually-wrapped presents to 172 children in middle schools in Floyd County, KY. We also gave hooded sweatshirts and jackets to 56 high school students at the David School, an alternative high school in Floyd County. For the first time, we were able to serve 60 senior citizens at the Prestonsburg Health Center through gift bags with personal care items. In Louisville, we sent gifts to 171 residents at Boys and Girls Haven. We also provided presents to 57 families and children at our sister parish, Holy Name. With help from other SVDP members, Pat Crowe coordinated the LOF in-person shopping for eastern Kentucky and Heather Lilla coordinated the online shopping in Louisville. Your SVDP expresses our deep gratitude to HT parishioners for your love and sharing of your blessings through Links of Friendship. And here is a note from the Floyd Co. Schools Coordinator:

Dear Holy Trinity Parishioners,
I want to send a sincere "thank you" to Links of Friendship at Holy Trinity parish. During our 5-year relationship, Links of Friendship has been nothing short of amazing. Your church's congregation has touched so many children and families' lives in such a positive way. The economic state in Appalachia is so depressed since the loss of the coal industry; then the Covid Pandemic that never seems like it is going to go away. There is a great need in our area simply for basic needs. The toys and fun kids' things were an added bonus to the kids' Christmas. 

LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Prophets possess an intimate knowledge of God and act on their experience of God. Prophetic messages usually challenge the status quo and draw us up and out of ourselves, focusing us on the bigger picture. We often think of ourselves and our own needs first. When we listen to someone speak, we judge the merit of the message by its degree of usefulness. If the message or vision contains no personal benefit or profit but a call to stretch and grow, we can become indignant. Prophets are usually the ones whose message challenges us and calls us to see things differently and love more perfectly and deeply. God is love. When listening to St. Paul speak about love we witness the unfolding of this type of unconditional, other centered, self-sacrificial perfect God. It is an invitation to life, freedom, and happiness that can be offered to us only by God. Jesus, who is God and Love incarnate, calls us to this richer expression of love. Are we ready to listen and be challenged and stretched?



SAINT OF THE WEEK

You may be familiar with the annual “blessing of throats” that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise’s command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.


