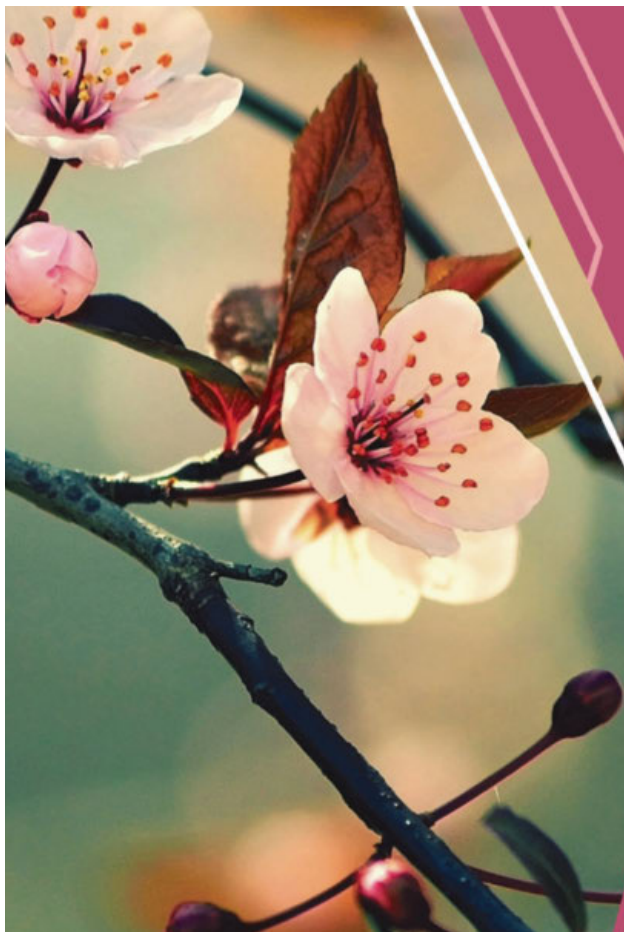

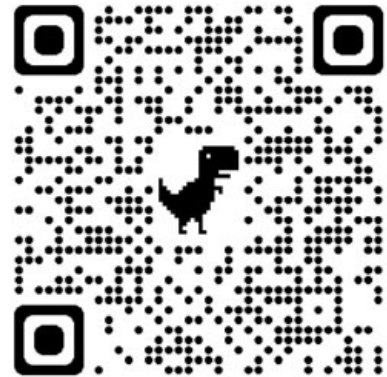

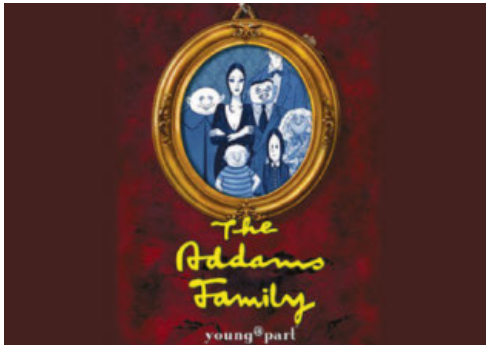

RCIA

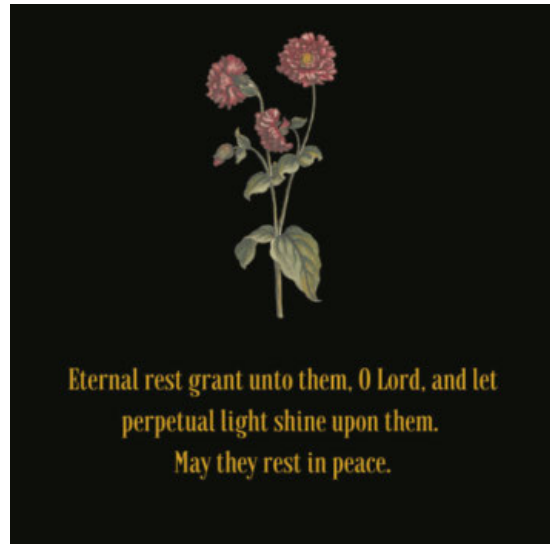

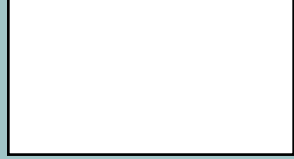
