


Are you ready to get out of the house? Get together with old friends or meet new ones? If so, then....


For Every Child Campaign

My Dear Holy Trinity Parishioners and School Families,

May God bless you in this holy season of Easter! I first want to thank you for your prayers and your words of welcome. It has been so nice to have received so many hospitable gestures, either through emails, Facebook posts, cards, etc. I am very grateful for you taking the time to do that for me, as I prepare to become your new shepherd.

I want to take this opportunity to also thank Fr. Wayne and Fr. Casey for their fraternal support and for Fr. Wayne's administration of the parish during this time of transition. Please keep all the Holy Trinity clergy and lay staff in your prayers during this time.

Unexpected transitions and unexpected changes are never easy, especially when they involve people, responsibilities, and personalities. One change that I have already implemented is to halt the President/Principal Model for both of our schools. I know a lot of work and thought was put into this model, but it was done under a previous administration with different visions, expectations, and leadership styles. I feel that it is important for me as Pastor, as the leader of this parish to discern a model that I believe will set us up for success as we strive to be the missionary disciples Christ has called us to be. In February of this year, Mr. Jack Richards signed a contract along with Fr. Bill Bowling, making him the President of Holy Trinity Schools on July 1, 2022. I will honor that signed contract. However, I have asked Mr. Richards to remain in his role as principal for the 2022-2023 school year and keep his responsibilities and duties as principal of both schools. Mr. Richards has agreed to this. Ms. Paula Watkins was also asked to remain as Head of School for Holy Trinity Clifton, and she will report to Mr. Richards. I want to thank both of them for their dedication and service!

As you may have heard, I love having a parish parochial school. The school is the largest ministry of the parish, and as Pastor, I promise you I will be present, I will be engaged, and I will be involved in the lives of your children. I will support our faculty, staff, and administration, and I will do everything in my power to make sure we are forming disciples who will pray, study, and serve together! Our Church depends on them, and I ask you to assist me in this most important endeavor.

Please continue to pray for me and be assured of my prayers for you! I look forward to serving you, and I resolve as your shepherd to do everything that I can, in the power of the Holy Spirit, to lead you to heaven.
