

Society at Work This month we contributed \$6100 toward the \$23,000 construction of a Walk-in Refrigerator unit at the SVDP Food Pantry so fresh vegetables and fruit can be stored and



distributed to needy families. Holy Trinity participates with five other parishes in this project to help families obtain sufficient and nutritious food.

In addition, we donated \$900 to purchase six beds and bedding at Boys and Girls Haven. We had 54 emergency assistance contacts in May, and pledged \$7375 toward them, primarily for help with rent and utilities.

We are most grateful to generous parishioners who contribute through We Share online, the collection envelopes and at church.


