

COMMUNITY

Holy Trinity offers a religious education program called GIFT, (Growing In Faith Together) for students in grades 1-8 who do not attend the parish school and/or are homeschooled. Sacramental preparation is included for students in grades 2 and 8, who have already had at least one year of formal religious education. GIFT classes take place weekly, between masses on Sundays, from 9:30a.m.-10:25a.m.; and run September through the end of April. There will be a "Welcome and Orientation" meeting for families on Sunday, August 28; at 10:00a.m., in the MPB. Classes begin on September 11 in the school classrooms. 
