

#### Novena for the Feast of the Assumption August 6-14

You are invited to pray the following Novena as a personal prayer request or as a group (family, committee or among friends) praying for a common special intention. Copies of thenovena prayers may be found in the info area or chapel. Lord Jesus Christ, You have destroyed the power of death and given the hope of eternal life in body and soul. You granted your Mother a special place in your glory, and did not allow decay to touch her body. As we rejoice in the Assumption of Mary, give to us a renewed confidence in the victory of life over death. You live and reign forever and ever. Amen.

#### What is a Novena?

A Novena is a nine day period of private or public prayer to obtain special graces, to implore special favors, or make special petitions. It usually either precedes or follows an important feast. When we pray a Novena, we either pray the same prayer for all nine days or follow a list of prayers to be prayed for a special intention for each day. Every novena is a bit different in the intention, formation of prayers and practice. The novena prayer may be said in conjunction with the rosary or scriptural readings. There are several sites online providing novenas for most feasts.



#### Holy Trinity offers a religious education program called GIFT, (Growing In Faith

**Together)** for students in grades 1-8 who do not attend the parish school and/or are homeschooled. Sacramental preparation is included for students in grades 2 and 8, who have already had at least one year of formal religious education. GIFT classes take place weekly, between masses on Sundays, from 9:30a.m.-10:25a.m.; and run September through the end of April. There will be a "Welcome and Orientation" meeting for families on Sunday, August 28; at 10:00a.m., in the MPB. Classes begin on September 11 in the school classrooms. 
Holy Trinity Parish School is looking for part-time and full time instructional assistants for the 2022-2023 school year.



#### LIVE THE LITURGY

#### Inspiration for the week

The fruits of our labors are not always seen in our lifetimes. Faith is not conditional on seeing results. Faith is a radical trust in what is unseen. It requires vigilance and self-investment. It requires our attention even when our efforts don't bear fruit or are unappreciated or unrecognized. A person who is open to accepting God's presence, however it comes, and is willing to share the love received with others is a true inspiration. Good works will flow from this vigilant depth of faith. It will be directed where it is most needed and detached from the need for recognition or gratitude. Faith exercised in secret is the most profound expression of faith and a testament of true love for our Creator. No one needs to know the humility, generosity, and goodness of our hearts, only God. Standing erect and watchful, we are prepared to receive the gift of Divine Love and freely share it with others, without recognition or self-benefit.



#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Jane Frances de Chantal was born to a noble family in Dijon, France, on January 28, 1572. Her mother died when she was an infant. Her father raised her and provided for her education. In 1592 She married the Baron de Chantal, the couple were devoted to each other. They had six children, three of whom died in infancy. As Baroness, Saint Jane Frances restored the custom of daily Mass, and was famous for her charitable works. Unfortunately, her husband died in a hunting accident only eight years after their marriage. Devastated Jane Frances was forced to live in her father-in-law's strict household where she took a vow of chastity.

In 1604 while visiting her father in Dijon, she met Saint Francis de Sales and he became her close friend and spiritual director. Although not many of their epistles have survived, the pair had a lively correspondence which lasted until Saint Francis died.

Under the direction of St. Francis de Sales and with his partnership she established the Congregation of the Visitation at Annecy in 1610. This was a unique order, without the extreme ascetical practices typical in other religious orders, accepting women and girls and those rejected by other orders because of poor health or age. The new order was also unusual in its public ministry, rather than a strictly cloistered life. Saint Jane transformed her convent at Annecy into a hospital during the plague of 1628.

The saint died at the Visitation Convent in Moulins on December 13, 1641. At the time of her death, there were 86 convents of Visitation nuns. She was canonized in 1767 by Pope Clement XIII.
