



Archbishop Shelton's Pallium Mass

The Archdiocese of Louisville invites all of the people of the Archdiocese to celebrate the Mass with the Imposition of the Sacred Pallium upon His Excellency The Most Reverend Shelton J. Fabre, Archbishop of Louisville by His Excellency, the Most Reverend Christophe Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio to the United States. This will take place on Tuesday, September 20, 2022, 6:00 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Assumption (433 South Fifth Street, Louisville). The pallium itself was blessed at a special Mass in the Vatican by His Holiness Pope Francis on June 29, the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. Archbishop Shelton explains the meaning and history of the pallium in his August 25 column in The Record. A reception in the Undercroft will follow the Mass. A Letter from Holy Name Parish Council

September 11, 2022

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

We are the members of the parish council of Holy Name parish, writing to you to express our profound thanks for the time we shared as a parish cluster with you.

God's love and care for us is astonishing. This was never so apparent than when Holy Name was raised from the depth of despair to the joy of being able to proclaim the Good News. Six years ago, Holy Name was on the brink of closure. The membership was down to historic lows and the finances were very poor. God reached out to Holy Name through the parishioners of Holy Trinity. Holy Trinity was paired with Holy Name as a sister parish by the Archbishop. Holy Trinity parish stepped up with priestly support, pastoral staff support, and financial support.

Under Fr. Mark's (Bishop Mark) leadership, beginning in January 2016, the interior of the church was cleaned and repaired, the undercroft was improved, and with the help of formation staff we were able to start religious education for our children. A ministry that served 20 families its first year and has now nurtured the faith in over 62 families with over 70 children. With the help of worship staff we were able to improve our liturgy with music and other ministries.

When Fr. Bill arrived in 2018 we were able to continue this good work. With the help of administrative staff we improved the interior of the church, replacing the HVAC systems that had broken, replacing the sound system, and making further improvements to parish worship. We cleaned and enhanced the rectory and cleaned and landscaped the church yard. We established a parish council and began recreating parish ministry committees. Our collaboration with Holy Trinity's St. Vincent de Paul Society on various efforts including Links of Friendship over the past four years has served over 80 Holy Name families. In addition during Advent, the collaborative participation of the Holy Trinity Health Ministry committee member and Young Couples members' presence and celebration of faith during community gatherings such as Las Posadas and parking fundraising provided fellowship experiences for both communities. Most recently, we were able to begin the Fr. Jack Jones Food Pantry along with Catholic Charities. We have faithful volunteers from Holy Trinity who continue to assist with this outreach to the poor in our area.

Your support has allowed for Holy Name to start anew and our membership and financials are improving. You have given us the opportunity to further spread the Good News of the Gospel. We do not take for granted this gift that you have bestowed on us. Holy Name is so very appreciative and thankful for the support from Holy Trinity.

As the Parish Council for Holy Name, we wanted to reach out to show our appreciation for the sharing of your Time, Talent, and Treasures with our parish family. You will always hold a special place in our heart for your selfless and loving support of Holy Name.

The full extent of all that Holy Trinity has done for us may never be fully seen by us; but we know that it was very generous and very loving.




