MISSION STATEMENT





ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CONFERENCE IN ACTION



Holy Trinity's St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP)

Conference works under the auspices of the Louisville SVdP Council to provide assistance to individuals and families in need in our parish and throughout the community. Programs operate yearlong as well as through annual seasonal projects.



Emergency Assistance: This committee coordinates assistance to individuals and families who need emergency help to stay housed or to be able to work. It provides one-time monetary assistance for help with rent, a mortgage, utilities, car repairs, etc. Since January, assistance has been provided to 358 clients at a total of \$42,748.



Friendship Visits: Members provide regular visits to older parishioners who are homebound, in the hospital, or living in congregate care facilities. This committee also involves HT first graders in making holiday greeting cards which it distributes to parish seniors. Ten ministers make 2400-2500 visits a year.



Food Pantry Collections: Food collected throughout the year is given to either the Father Jack Jones Pantry on the Holy Name campus or to the Louisville SVdP community pantry. This summer HT contributed \$6100 toward the construction of a Walkin Refrigerator at the SVdP pantry. Members assist with food distribution at both pantries.



Thanksgiving Partnership with St. Augustine: Since

2008, Holy Trinity has partnered with St. Augustine Parish to collect food and monetary donations for Thanksgiving food baskets for lowincome families in Jefferson County. We supported 175 families last Thanksgiving. Look for information for this year's food drive to be held October 15-November 6.



Christmas Links of Friendship: Last year Holy Trinity expanded this holiday giving program to provide gifts to children in Floyd County Schools, older adults at a Prestonsburg facility, youth at Boys and Girls Haven, and families at Holy Name parish. This year we will continue a program that combines online shopping for Boys and Girls Haven and Holy Name and in-person shopping for Floyd County families. Look for ways to participate beginning with our kick-off on November 12.



International Twinning: HT provides financial support to St. John Paul II School in Haiti.
