FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

My Dear Parishioners of Holy Trinity,

I write this letter to you, the faithful, on the Feast Day of Saint Francis of Assisi! How blessed we are as a parish in our works of justice, mercy, service, and compassion. I invite you to think about how many people we have helped over the years! Because of your generosity, your care for the poor and less fortunate, and your compassion for all of God's creation, like St. Francis of Assisi, you have preached the Gospel, not so much with your words, but more so with your actions. Each year the Archdiocese of Louisville, under the guidance and direction of the Archbishop, invites the faithful to actively participate in the Catholic Services Appeal. I arrived as your pastor just three and a half months ago and I have already witnessed your generous hearts and your care for others.

Holy Trinity has a wonderful reputation for being one of the parishes that always brings in the most money. Thank you!! I know that will continue this year. Last year our goal was **\$250,000** and we raised **\$254,043**. Amazing! Our donor/parishioner goal was **344** donors and unfortunately, we **did not** meet that goal. We had **253** donors. This year our financial goal is **\$255,000** and our parishioner/donor goal is **253** donors. I know we can surpass this and we will, especially because many of you have come to know how competitive I am.

I am inviting you once again to show your support for our Archdiocese. They need us, we need them, and all of us depend on and need one another. This year's theme is "[Comfort My People](#)." It is also the Episcopal Motto of our new shepherd, Archbishop Shelton Fabre. I want Archbishop Shelton to know, along with the entire Archdiocese, that Holy Trinity Catholic Church is committed to doing whatever it takes to Comfort God's People throughout the Archdiocese of Louisville.

By now you should have received a CSA Brochure from the Archdiocese along with a letter from Archbishop Shelton. Please pray about your donation this year, and give thanks to God for the gifts we've been given and the gifts we are blessed to share.

As you know, the Archdiocese provides key support for our parishes. Here are a few of the many ways your donations assist our parish along with the Archdiocese:

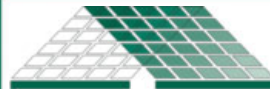
