

Advent Imagery around our Church - "O Radiant Dawn, splendor of eternal light, Sun of Justice: come and shine on those who dwell in darkness and in the shadow of death." An "O" antiphon for Advent

Advent is a time for prayer and reflection. We reflect back on the first coming of Jesus in Bethlehem, His Incarnation, and at the same time prepare for His second coming at the end of time. We are a people waiting in darkness for the Light of the World to enter---just as the Jewish people waited for the Messiah.

We wait with joyful expectation for the One who comes and will sit at the right hand of God the Father in heaven. With Christ's entrance into the world at Christmas, the image of the rising sun relates to Easter with His Resurrection, as the two events are intimately connected.

The forerunner of Christ, His cousin, John the Baptist, proclaimed His coming and exhorts us to "Prepare the way of the Lord." This is recalled daily in the Canticle of Zechariah (who was the father of John the Baptist), which is part of the morning prayers in the Liturgy of the Hours.

The pregnant Madonna has connections to the new Eve of Gen. 3:15 who would crush the head of the serpent; to the woman of the Book of Revelation chapter 12 with a crown of twelve stars whose offspring would rule all the nations; to the New Ark of the Covenant which contains the Word of God, and the Bread of Life in parallel to the Jewish ark of the covenant which contained the Ten Commandments and manna from the desert.
