Understanding Laudato Si'

Pope Francis' encyclical, *Laudato Si' – On Care For Our Common Home*, calls us toward sustainability in the spirit of integral ecology. With profound care for each other, our Creator and all creation, we are building a better future together. How can we implement *Laudato Si'* in our lives and institutions? At a series of presentations that will be held on the last Tuesdays of January, February, March and April, participants will read two chapters each month (the text can be provided upon request) and convene via Zoom to review and discuss this inspirational encyclical. The goal will be to imagine action steps based on those discussions. The fourth session will focus on what steps should be taken to put *Laudato Si'* into action within their parishes, communities and homes following Pope Francis' call for a seven-year action platform. These zoom meetings will be held from 7 to 8:30 p.m. EST on each of these Tuesdays.

These discussions will be co-facilitated by archdiocesan priest, Father Jim Flynn and Cory Lockhart, a Louisville-based and well-respected facilitator, teacher, artist, public speaker and peacemaker. They have been endorsed by Archbishop Shelton Fabre, who stated, "I would like to encourage people of this Archdiocese to become familiar with Pope Francis' Encyclical *Laudato Si' – On Care For Our Common Home*."

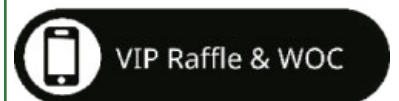
