Volunteer opportunities are available on May 19th and 20th (building walls at Habitat construction center in Portland) and June 1st, 2nd, and 3rd ("Raise The Roof" – first 3 days of on-site building). No skill is required; on-site training will be provided.

The home site is located at 628 E. Breckinridge St., Louisville, 40203. No more than 10 people are needed for the May dates and a maximum of 25 people are needed for each day in June. Men and women of the parish are invited to help and children 16+ (accompanied by a parent) can also be a part of our effort (HS service hours can be provided.) Additional volunteer dates for the on-site build will be provided later in the summer.
