



A Message from Father Casey

As many of you know, the Eucharistic Revival is well underway in the United States. As of Corpus Christi, the focus of the revival is now on the parish.

The Corpus Christi procession we held on June 11 was a kick-off to the revival at our parish. We hadn't had such a procession here in years, I am told! It was so beautiful and moving to process through our neighborhood with our Eucharistic Lord. We are continuing to discern how best to foster Eucharistic revival here at Holy Trinity. We will certainly continue Eucharistic Adoration every Tuesday evening after Mass until 9:30pm.

As we know, the Mass is the source and summit of all that we do. Revival must start and end there. The Second Vatican Council called for liturgical reform to be undertaken with an emphasis on noble simplicity. By noble, the Council meant everything in the Mass - gestures and sacred music, in particular - is to be rich in meaning. By simplicity, it meant those elements are to be relatively understandable with some liturgical formation; let us not forget, however, that the Mass is a mystery beyond all telling!

With noble simplicity in mind, then, we are introducing changes to our sacred music as we return to Ordinary Time on June 17. You will notice new beautiful sacred hymns and greater use of instrumentals, especially during the Preparation of the Gifts. Instrumentals are an opportunity for the congregation to peacefully meditate on the mystery before them without worrying about the lyrics of the hymn. Further, we will be choosing hymns throughout Ordinary Time that highlight the devotional emphasis of that particular month. For example, June will focus on the Sacred Heart of Jesus and July on His Most Precious Blood. We hope these changes help you to pray the Mass well as you actively and fully participate in the Eucharistic Sacrifice.

Let us continue to strive toward Eucharistic revival here at our parish. Please pray for Fr. Shayne and me that we may discern how best to foster that.


