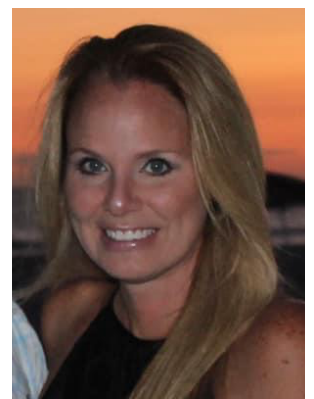
HOLY TRINITY CLIFTON CAMPUS
