Dear Friends in Christ,

Our parish community has a unique opportunity to serve more children. This past weekend, we revealed our plans in more detail to do this through our *For Every Child* Campaign. This is a time for Holy Trinity to enter into a deeper relationship with our loving God and respond to His call of providing more meaningful service to our community. Hopefully, this calling inspires each of us to gratefully consider ways in which we may share our time, talent, and treasure with our church.

I ask you to prayerfully consider a generous response to this campaign, covering four unique components:

- 1. Fully accessible playgrounds on the Cherrywood campus
- 2. Enhanced nursery adjacent to the church's gathering space to care for young children during our liturgies
- 3. Educational programming for children with language-based learning differences at the Clifton Campus School
- 4. Development of the fine arts program with enhancements to our historic theater at the Clifton Campus School

I am especially proud of our expansion of Catholic Elementary education to serve children with language-based learning differences (e.g. dyslexia, ADHD). Prior to the opening of our Holy Trinity Clifton Campus School, there were no Catholic school options for these families. Our school is open to all children throughout the Archdiocese and will aid in the transition of these students to our local Catholic high schools, all of which have learning difference programs. Already, our community has shown great momentum and support of this project, with gifts and pledges to date exceeding \$1,600,000. I pray you will join in supporting these dynamic new ministries for children. Please see the enclosed brochure which features many of the enhancements that will be made to the Clifton building to serve children with learning differences as well as to expand our fine arts program for all children enrolled at both campuses. If you would like more specific information about this program, I hope you will consider stopping by one of the open houses we have scheduled for the fall, or reach out to Rachel Schrepferman, Volunteer Campaign Chair, Beth Klem, or myself.

Please know that the time, talent, and treasure you give **today** will reap enormous dividends **tomorrow**.
