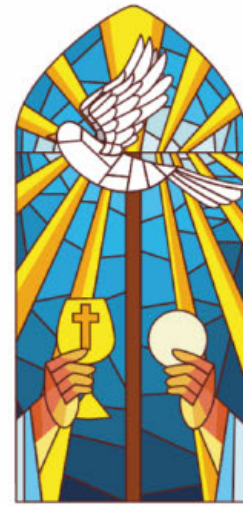

Immaculate Heart of Mary

The Catholic Church dedicates the month of August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. During this month, we ask for Mary's intercessions to help us purify our own hearts and grow closer to her Son and our Savior, Jesus Christ.

Depictions of the Immaculate Heart of Mary usually include the symbols of a sword, fire, and roses. The fire represents the burning love that Mary has for Jesus and all of us, and the roses that surround her Heart represent her purity. The sword symbolizes the sword from Luke 2:34-35: "and Simeon blessed them and said to Mary his mother, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be contradicted (and you yourself a sword will pierce) so that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."

As we pray and attend Mass this month, let us all reflect on how we can model our own heart after the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Is our heart on fire with burning love for Jesus? Have we prayed for a more pure heart and partaken of the Sacrament of Reconciliation when we have sinned? Have we prayed for Mary's intercession to help us with the swords of grief, sorrow, and sin that pierce our own hearts?

Music at our weekend Masses will feature Marian hymns like "Hail, Holy Queen Enthroned Above" and "Immaculate Mary." This August, let us all raise our voices in song and prayer as we pray:

O Most Blessed Mother, heart of love, heart of mercy, ever listening, caring, consoling, hear our prayer. As your children, we implore your intercession with Jesus your Son. Receive with understanding and compassion the petitions we place before you today, especially... (special intention).

We are comforted in knowing your heart is ever open to those who ask for your prayer. We trust to your gentle care and intercession, those whom we love and who are sick or lonely or hurting. Help all of us, Holy Mother, to bear our burdens in this life until we may share eternal life and peace with God forever. Amen.
