My Dear Parishioners of Holy Trinity,

I write this letter to you, the faithful, on the Feast Day of the Guardian Angels! It is that time once again to make someone else's life just a little bit better. After all, isn't that what a guardian angel does for us? Tries to make our lives a little happier? A little safer? A little more secure and consistent? Just a little bit better? This year's CSA theme is: Do this in Memory of Me. We hear this profound statement from our Blessed Lord, every time Mass is celebrated and the Eucharist is broken and shared. As you discern what you are able to do again this year for someone else, I invite you to give to the CSA in memory of someone. Maybe this person has gone to God surrounded by a cloud of angels, or perhaps this person is still alive. No matter the reason, anytime we do something for someone else - to make their lives just a little bit better - we do so in memory of Jesus Christ. Do this in Memory of Me.

Holy Trinity has a wonderful reputation for being one of the parishes that always brings in the most money. Thank you!! We certainly did that this past year. Our goal was \$255,000 and we brought in \$303,974. Our donor goal was 253 and 458 donors made a contribution! That was a huge success. Once again, I am asking you, especially those who have never given to the CSA or have stopped for whatever reason, to give something to the CSA. With 1800 families, we should have at least 800-900 donors. I know we can do it, so let us do it in memory of someone we know and love, someone we know or don't know, who can benefit from our generosity. Do this in Memory of Me.

This year, our 2023 our goals are: 461 Donors \$265,000

I am inviting you once again to show your support for our Archdiocese. They need us, we need them, and all of us depend on and need one another. When I stand there at the altar, representing Jesus Christ Himself, and I hold the Chalice, after having been blessed and consecrated by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, I look out at the people of God, and I am so thankful you are there with us at Mass. I look out and see people who are helpers, who have received help, and those who are always wanting to do more. Now is your chance, now is our opportunity, and while I am looking out at the people, I simply say, "Do this in Memory of Me." We are a Eucharistic People, and we give thanks for the many blessings that God has given us, and it is up to us to share those blessings with others.

By now you should have received a CSA Brochure from the Archdiocese along with a letter from Archbishop Shelton. Please pray about your donation this year, and give thanks to God for the gifts we've been given and what we will share in memory of someone else.

As you know, the Archdiocese <u>provides key support</u> for our parishes. Here are a few of the many ways your donations assist our parish along with the Archdiocese:

- · Clergy Funding is provided for seminary costs, ongoing priest formation, diaconate formation, as well as support for retired diocesan priests. On behalf of Fr. Wayne and Fr. Casey– we thank you for supporting us through CSA. We were also blessed to have Deacon Kenny Nauert with us this summer. He will be ordained a priest in the spring and your CSA donations help get him through seminary without having to worry about financial burdens or stresses.
- Faith Formation catechesis, conferences, workshops, training sessions, and parish resources. These are the many resources our catechists and schools use on a daily basis.
- · Family Ministry marriage prep, resources for married couples, family counseling, safe environment training.
- · Worship liturgical direction, liturgical minister formation, parish resources.




