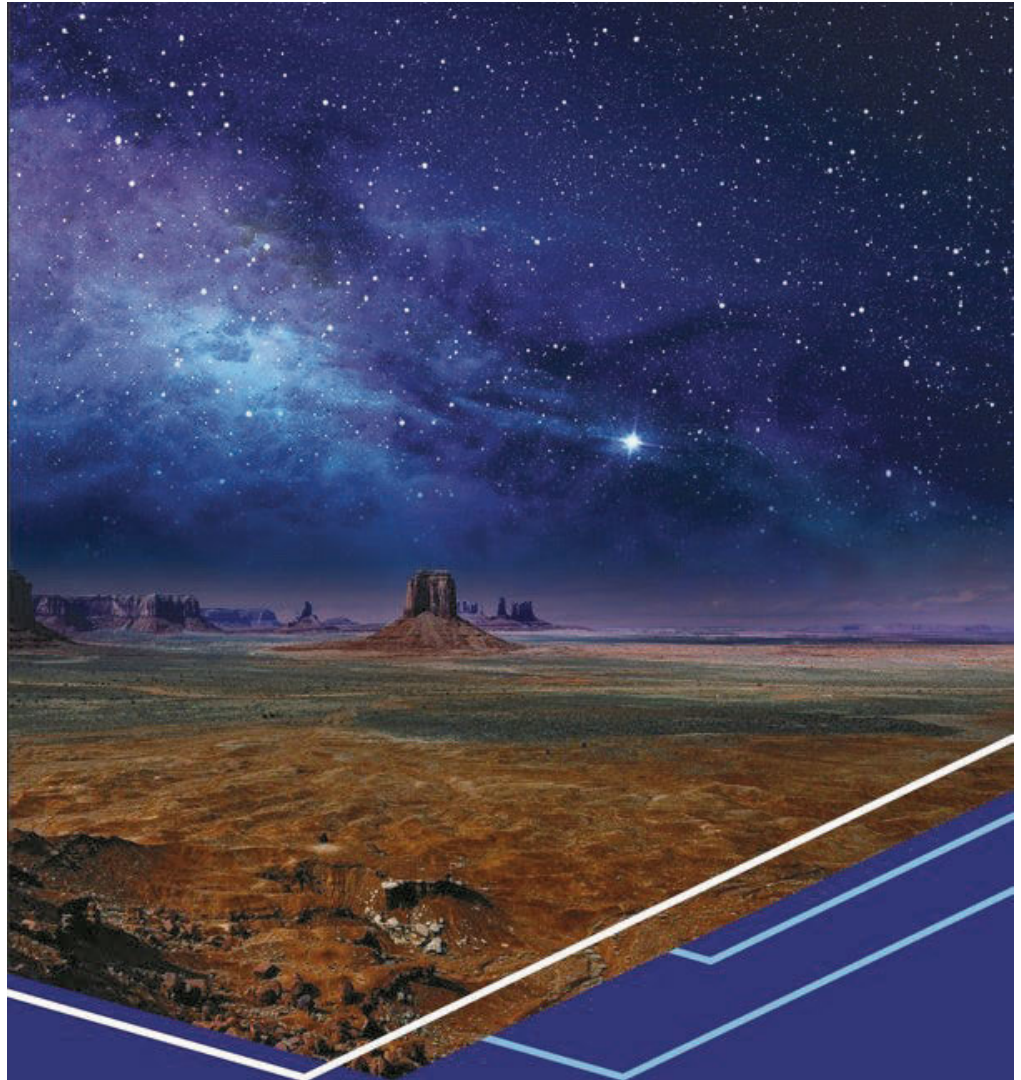

Did You Know?

This weekend's hymn selections might be broadly characterized as "Christmas carols" by popular culture. But liturgically speaking, they are more properly termed "Epiphany carols." A Christmas carol centers on the Holy Family and the event of Christ's birth; an Epiphany carol focuses more on the reception of that news by shepherds, Magi, and all nations—even us today! Another way that we can celebrate this news is to write the Epiphany Blessing with chalk on our doors. The Chalking of the Doors is a centuries-old tradition throughout the world. We dedicate our year to God, asking for his blessing on our homes and all who live, work, and visit them. The letters in the blessing (20 + C + M + B + 24) have two meanings: the initials of the Magi—Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar—and the initials of the Latin phrase *Christus mansionem benedicat*, which translates to, "May Christ bless this house." The "+" represents the cross, and the "20" at the beginning and the "24" at the end mark the year of blessing.

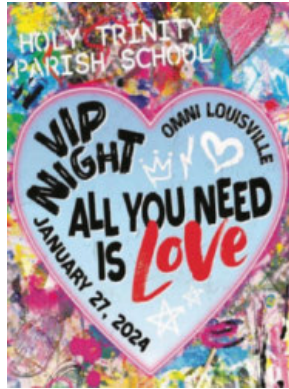


MASS INTENTION GUIDELINES

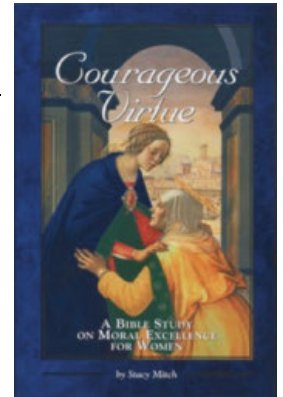

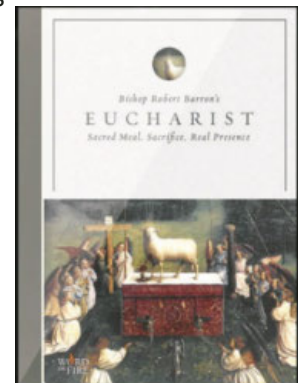
